



### REACH Georgia Student Commitment

The REACH Georgia Program is designed to provide academically promising students with the comprehensive support needed to persist through middle and high school, gain access to college, and achieve post-secondary success.

I, \_\_\_\_\_ (print student's name), understand that participating in the REACH Georgia Program requires dedication, motivation, and commitment. Upon becoming a REACH Scholar, I commit to the following:

- Create a GA Futures account at [www.gafutures.org](http://www.gafutures.org) within 30 days of becoming a REACH scholar.
- Adhere to my school's attendance policy and will attend classes regularly.
- Maintain at least a 2.5 HOPE Scholarship grade point average as computed by GSFA. If my grades fall below a 2.5 average, I will work with my academic coach to develop an action plan to help my grades improve.
- Participate in all scheduled REACH Georgia related activities, meetings, and programs.
- Follow my school's code of conduct and behave in a positive way that reflects the program standards, both in and out of school.
- Remain drug and crime free.
- Meet with my matched mentor a minimum of eight times per semester during the school year.
- Meet with my academic coach a minimum of four times per semester during the school year.
- Persist in my education to graduate from high school with a final HOPE calculated GPA of 2.5 or greater and meet all the admissions requirements to enroll in a HOPE-eligible college or university in the state of Georgia.

I understand the following:

- If my attendance, behavior, participation, and/or grades do not meet the stated school and/or the program requirements, I will be at risk of being withdrawn from REACH Georgia permanently.
- If I am incarcerated or convicted of criminal behavior, I will immediately be withdrawn from REACH Georgia.
- To be eligible for the financial scholarship (\$2,500 per year for up to 4 years), I will need to:
  - Graduate from high school with a diploma and a final HOPE calculated GPA of 2.5 or greater;
  - Enroll full-time in a HOPE-eligible college or university in the state of Georgia;
  - Maintain a 2.0+ HOPE GPA in college and meet the postsecondary institution's Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements;
- It is my responsibility to maintain my GA Futures account and keep the REACH Georgia program at GSFC informed of any changes to my contact information or enrollment location to ensure my scholarship eligibility is maintained at the postsecondary level.
